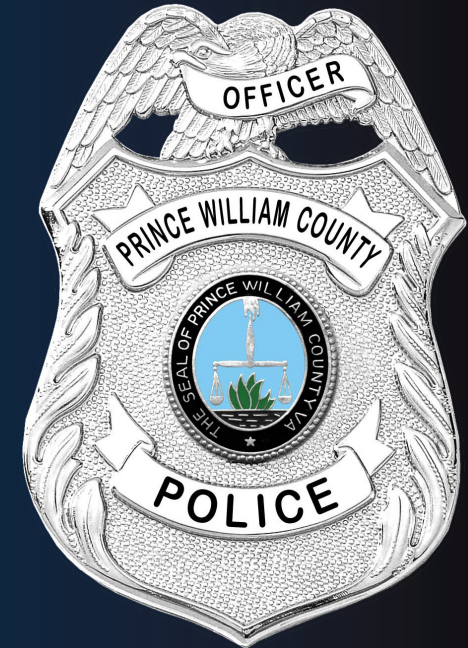

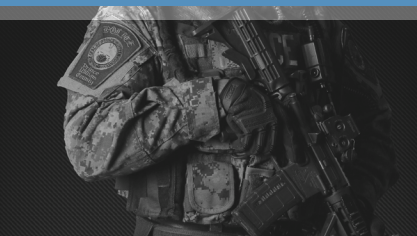
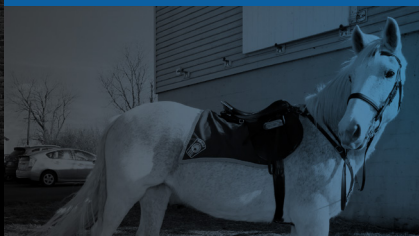

Minimum Qualifications

- U.S. citizen

Physical Fitness Assessment

- 1.5 miles in 17:00 (minutes : seconds)
- Bench Press 60% of body weight
